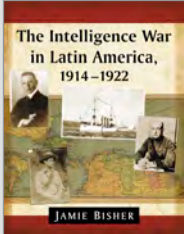

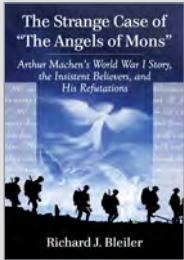


THE INTELLIGENCE WAR IN LATIN AMERICA, 1914-1922
